Curriculum Coverage

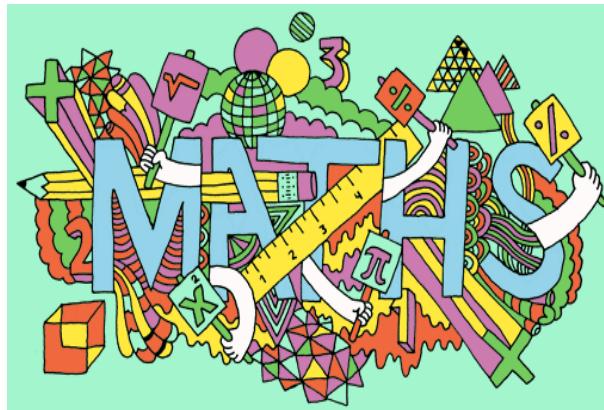
Within Literacy we will be looking at the following areas:
