During Term 5 and 6 we will be exploring our natural world, recycling, caring for our planet, animals and comparing where and how we live, to those around the world.

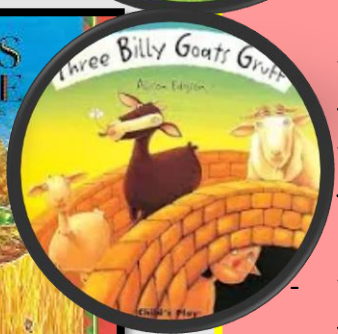
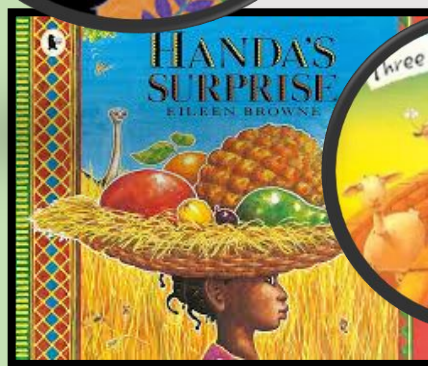
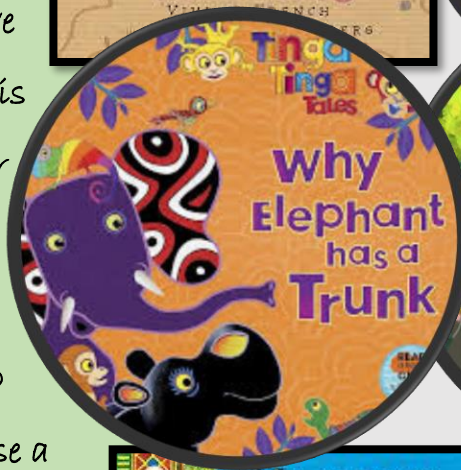
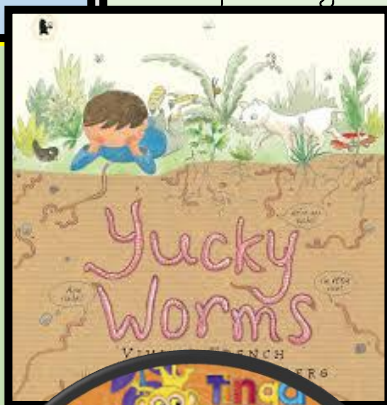
We will be consolidating our knowledge of digraphs and trigraphs this term whilst also learning how to read and blend longer words and sentences.
