<u>History</u>

Our topic for term 5 is Florence Nightingale. We are learning about her impact during the Crimean war and how she improved hospitals.



Geography

Our topic for term 6 is Let's go on a safari. This will involve exploring the different oceans, the climate in Africa and how to use a compass.

<u>Science</u>

This term we will be learning about bulbs and seeds. We will conduct an investigation exploring whether warmer or colder temperatures help a plant to grow better.

After this we will be learning about growing up. This will include life cycles of different animals.



In R.E. for both terms our big question is What is a Muslim and what do they believe in? We be exploring different areas of this religion and stories the Prophet Muhammad shared with his followers.

<u>English</u>
