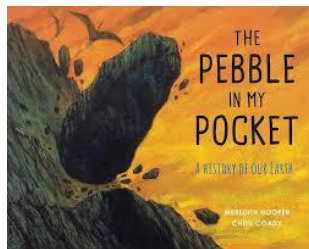
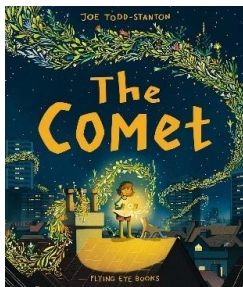


# Year 3 Newsletter

## Terms 1 & 2

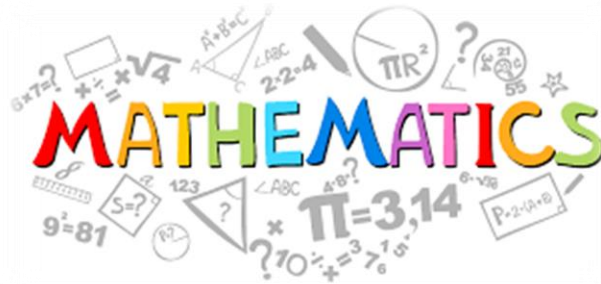
Within Literacy we will be looking at the following areas:

- Addition and subtraction
- Multiplication and division
