# Curriculum Coverage

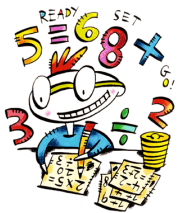
In English we will be looking at:

In **Geography & History** we will be looking at:

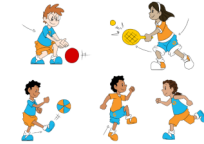
