## Maths

## ART/DT

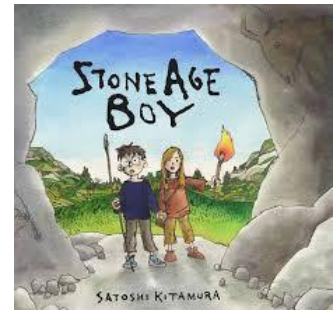
As part of our Design Technology week Year 3 will be designing and making stick Stone Age puppets.
